

# Polyvine Varnish and Paint Remover - Help Sheet

# **Product Overview**

Polyvine Varnish and Paint Remover is a non-toxic, household-safe solution designed to strip multiple layers of varnish, paint, and finishes from a variety of surfaces. Suitable for interior and exterior use, it requires no ventilation and leaves no need to neutralise the substrate.

This product doesn't work like a traditional corrosive paint stripper - this formula means that the coating does not blister or crack in front of your eyes, it softens and lifts the coating for easy and safe removal.

- Coverage: 1 litre covers approx. 4–6 m² (40–60 sq. ft per quart), depending on coating and thickness.
- VOC Content: Ultra-low (1 g/L).

# **Application Instructions**

Test First: Always perform a small test on an inconspicuous area to determine dwell time, performance, and substrate compatibility.

Shake Well: Ensure the product flows evenly.

Apply Liberally: Use a brush to apply a generous layer. Keep the surface saturated and wet during dwell time.

Dwell Time: Leave on the surface for 30–45 minutes (or longer as needed).

 For stubborn coatings or hot outdoor conditions, cover with plastic sheeting to prevent drying and extend dwell time.

### Removal:

- Scrape off using a scraper or stainless-steel scouring ball.
- Do not use wire wool (causes rust).
- If necessary, repeat application and wash residue with a damp cloth or water.
- Sand any remaining traces.



## Clean-Up

- Clean equipment with soap and water before drying.
- Wipe excess product from surfaces with a damp cloth.

# Storage

- Store in a cool, dry place.
- Protect from extremes of temperature.
- Do not allow to freeze.

# Safety Guidance

- Apply only as directed.
- Wash hands after use.
- Do not mix with other products.
- For prolonged use or when removing toxic/lead-based paints, wear protective gloves.
- Keep out of reach of children.

If in contact with eyes: Rinse immediately with warm water.

If swallowed: Seek medical advice and show the container/label.

# **Environmental & Disposal**

- Non-hazardous formulation.
- Do not pour into drains or watercourses.
- Dispose of via local special waste facilities.
