

## CHALK PAINT ANTIQUING WAXER

### DESCRIPTION

This unique brush on antique wax finish maintains the velvet smooth, chalky finish of your paint, whilst producing an aged finish. It can be buffed to leave your piece with a smooth waxy texture.

**ideal to use for** • vintage look furniture • upcycled furniture • distressing • shabby chic

**unique qualities** • velvet smooth • traditional silky feel of wax • protects against scuffing • prevents water damage • low odour • brushes and tools wash in water

### APPLICATION

Apply 2 coats of clear Chalk Paint Waxer Satin with a varnishing brush over dry chalk paint. Allow waxer to dry. This seals the chalk paint to enable the working of the antique waxer over the surface. To obtain your antique/aged finish apply Chalk Paint Antiquing Waxer with a varnishing brush and lightly remove any excess with a soft cloth to age and give texture to your paintwork. Work into the paint to highlight brush strokes, cracks and mouldings. This process will leave a silk finish. If a completely dead flat final finish is required, apply Chalk Paint Waxer Dead Flat.

**caution** Always apply to a test area before starting work. Appearance may vary according to the colour and type of paint and the number of coats. Do not apply over uncured paints.

### COVERAGE

Approx. 15 sq. m per litre, 150 sq. ft per US qt

### SHEEN LEVEL

Satin

### CONTAINERS

500ml, US pint,

### DRYING TIME

15mins-1 hr, depending on temperature

### RECOAT TIME

2hrs – 4hrs

### CURING

Protect the finish from water and steam for 5 Days after application

### CLEANING

Clean tools/equipment with warm soapy water, rinse well with clean water, allow to dry naturally.

### STORAGE

Protect from extremes of temperature during storage and application.

### CAUTION.

Always apply to a test area before starting work.

Appearance may vary according to the colour and type of paint and the number of coats.

### HEALTH SAFETY AND THE ENVIROMENT

Non-hazardous. Ensure good ventilation. Keep out of reach of children. Contact with eyes-wash immediately with warm water. Remove excess from tools and mixing vessels before washing in warm soapy water. Do not empty containers into drains or watercourses.
